## **ERP Analyst Programmer**

The ERP Analyst Programmer will be responsible for analysis and programming duties in the development, implementation and support of information systems and applications.

### **Main Responsibilities**

- ▶ Create and implement the company's IT policies and regulations with regards to cyber security
- ▶ Analyse user information system needs
- ▶ Document the ERP system functionality and requirements
- ▶ Arrange project requirements in programming sequence by analysing requirements, preparing a workflow chart and diagram using knowledge of computer capabilities, subject matter expertise, programming language, and logic
