Key Responsibilities

- ▶ Daily bookkeeping of selected Polish companies (operating entities and project companies): bank statement reconciliation, A/P and A/R subledger reconciliation, fixed asset register, payroll journals (based on input payroll calculation data from external payroll agency), VAT processing with tax advisor, cooperation with local staff, issuing invoices.
- ▶ Monthly closing: review of subledgers, ensuring full completion of monthly closing transactions (depreciation, FX revaluation, accruals, provisions, etc.), overall review of reported standalone figures (financial statements), documentation of the B/S and P/L items, clarification of differences of payables/receivables for other Group entities, annual reports and financial statements preparation in accordance with group accounting rules.
- ▶ Ongoing cooperation with the accounting and consolidation manager and other colleagues within the financial department, and with the tax advisor for a local legislation.
- ▶ Collaboration with auditors during annual close.
- ▶ Other tasks related to accounting and administration, support of the local team relating to finance matters
